4. Assembly and Setup

Your Mango Beach Cruisers Macaw 7 may arrive partially assembled. Follow these steps to complete the assembly:

Tools Needed:

- Adjustable wrench
- Phillips screwdriver
- 4,5,6 Allen wrenches
- Tire pump

Assembly Instructions:

1. **Unbox the bicycle:** Carefully unpack the bicycle, ensuring all parts (frame, wheels, pedals, handlebars, saddle, etc.) are present.
 2. **Attach the handlebars:**
 - Insert the handlebar stem into the front fork and adjust the height.
 - Align the handlebars with the front wheel and tighten the stem bolt with an Allen wrench.
 - Adjust the angle of the handlebars to your preference and tighten all bolts securely.
 3. **Install the front wheel:**
 - Place the front wheel in the front fork dropouts.
 - Tighten the axle nuts with a wrench, ensuring the wheel is centered and spins freely.
 4. **Attach the pedals:**
 - Identify the left and right pedals (marked "L" and "R").
 - Screw the right pedal clockwise into the right crank arm.
 - Screw the left pedal counterclockwise into the left crank arm.
 - Tighten both pedals with a wrench.
 5. **Install the saddle:**
 - Insert the seat post into the seat tube, adjusting the height for comfort.
 - Tighten the seat clamp bolt to secure the saddle.
 6. **Inflate the tires:**
 - Use a tire pump to inflate both tires to the recommended pressure (indicated on the tire sidewall).
 7. **Final check:**
 - Ensure all bolts and fasteners are tightened.
 - Test the brakes and gear shifting to ensure everything is functioning correctly.

5. Understanding the 7-Speed Gears

The Macaw 7 features a **Shimano 7-speed derailleur system**, which allows for smoother, more efficient riding across various terrains.

Gear Overview:

- **1st Gear:** Easiest for climbing hills or when you need minimal resistance.
- **2nd-4th Gears:** Medium resistance for moderate speeds and gradual inclines.
- **5th-7th Gears:** Higher resistance for flat terrain or when riding at faster speeds.

Shifting Tips:

- Always **pedal lightly** when shifting to prevent damage to the drivetrain.

- **Do not shift gears while stationary;** gears should only be shifted when the bike is moving.
 - Use lower gears for hills and higher gears for flat surfaces or when you want to go faster.
 - Familiarize yourself with gear changes by practicing in a safe, open space.

6. Riding Instructions

Basic Riding Tips:

1. **Mounting the bike:** Stand beside the bicycle, hold the handlebars, and swing one leg over the saddle. Place your foot on a pedal and push off to start riding.
2. **Pedaling:** As you start pedaling, shift to an appropriate gear depending on the terrain (use 1st gear for hills, mid-range gears for moderate speeds, and higher gears for flat surfaces).
3. **Braking:** The Macaw 7 is equipped with a front V-brake and rear hand brake. Use both brakes to slow down smoothly. For an emergency stop, apply both brakes evenly to avoid skidding.
4. **Turning:** Lean into turns gently and maintain balance by slightly shifting your body weight.

Riding in Traffic:

- Stay in bike lanes and obey all traffic signals.
 - Use hand signals when turning or stopping.
 - Ride in the same direction as traffic and be aware of your surroundings.

7. Maintenance and Care

Regular maintenance is essential to keep your Mango Beach Cruisers Macaw 7 running smoothly.

Cleaning:

- **Frame:** Clean the frame with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid using a hose, as excess water can damage components.
- **Tires:** Clean the tires and rims to remove dirt and debris. Check for any wear or damage.
- **Chain and gears:** Regularly lubricate the chain and derailleur to ensure smooth gear shifting. Wipe off excess oil to prevent dirt buildup.

Routine Checks:

- **Tire pressure:** Check the tire pressure before each ride. Ensure both tires are inflated to the recommended PSI.
- **Brakes:** Test the front and rear brakes to ensure they engage properly. If the brake lever feels loose or braking is less effective, adjust the brake cables or pads.
- **Gears:** Check gear shifting performance regularly. If the gears are not shifting smoothly, the derailleur may need adjustment.
- **Bolts and fasteners:** Inspect and tighten all bolts, especially on the wheels, handlebars, and saddle.

Brake Pad Replacement:

If your brakes are squeaking or not providing enough stopping power, the brake pads may need to be replaced. Visit a local bike shop if you're unsure how to replace them.

8. Storage

- **Indoor storage:** Store the bike in a cool, dry place to prevent rust or damage from moisture. Hang it on a wall or use a bike stand if space is limited.
 - **Outdoor storage:** If you need to store your bike outdoors, use a waterproof cover to protect it from rain, sun, and other elements.
 - **Long-term storage:** For long-term storage, clean and lubricate the chain and gears, and slightly deflate the tires to prevent cracking. Store the bike in a vertical position or suspended if possible to reduce pressure on the tires.

9. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gears not shifting smoothly	Derailleur misaligned	Adjust the derailleur or visit a bike shop
Weak braking	Worn brake pads or loose cables	Adjust or replace brake pads, tighten brake cables
Flat or soft tires	Puncture or low tire pressure	Inflate tires to recommended PSI or repair the puncture

Squeaking or grinding noise	Dry chain or gears	Lubricate chain and gears
Unstable ride	Loose wheels or handlebars	Tighten bolts on the wheels or handlebars

10. Warranty Information

What is Covered:

- Frame defects
